

The safety and security of the Jones-Carter Gallery's visitors, staff, and exhibits is of the highest importance. When you visit the gallery, you will discover that we have security measures in place to ensure your safety and the safety of the art contained within. You will be greeted upon entry by one of our security personnel who will check large items at our reception desk and ensure that prohibited items are not brought into the gallery. Because of security measures, lines for entry may be long during peak times to view exhibits. We ask for your patience, cooperation, and assistance in keeping the gallery and exhibits safe. Thank you for your cooperation.

Prohibited Items

- Smoking is prohibited inside and on the grounds of the Jones-Carter Gallery.
- Diaper bags
- Food including carry-out, lunch boxes, coolers, etc.
- Drinks including closed, unopened, and empty bottles.
- Bags over 11" X 15" X 6" including book bags, backpacks, brief cases, large camera cases, large laptop cases, etc.
- Umbrellas, tripods, monopods, rolled posters, etc.
- Ink pens, art supplies, easels and easel boards.
- Wagons
- Balloons
- Any item deemed non-permissible by Jones-Carter Gallery or security staff.

Permitted Items

- Purses and bags under 11"X15"X6"
- Canes, walkers, crutches, strollers, wheelchairs, oxygen tanks
- Service animals

Photography

Photography is not allowed of traveling exhibitions inside the Jones-Carter Gallery. Working members of the media must obtain permission from the Gallery manager and be escorted through the gallery by a staff member in order to take photographs for the press.
